Welcome to Pre-K3!

Pre-K3 students will only need the following items listed below for school this year. I will supply each child with a folder and the school will supply crayons, pencils, and any other items needed for our learning activities. **\*\*PLEASE BE SURE TO LABEL ALL SUPPLIES WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME\*\***

Thank you.

- 1 Backpack large enough to fit a folder and a lunch box
- 1 labeled Plastic Pencil box to hold their crayons at school
- 1 Lunch box/lunch bag
- 2 Rolls of paper towels
- 1 Box of tissues
- 2 Containers of baby wipes
- 2 Containers of disinfecting wipes
- 1 Complete set of extra clothes that will kept inside each child's backpack (Please keep in a labeled zip-lock bag, thanks.)
- 1 Beach towel for circle time. (Please label.)
- A small blanket and a sheet or 2 small blankets for rest time. (Please label and place in a labeled reusable bag.)
- Coloring Book (To keep in cubby)

Optional items:

- Lysol can spray or similar product
- Zip lock bags (sizes: sandwich, quart and gallon)

While you are shopping, you may want to purchase extra supplies to keep at home. The following list contains optional items that your children can use at home to enhance their learning.

- A 1 inch Hard Cover Binder (in any color - with a transparent pocket on the front) This will be used for your child's end of the year Memory Book.
- (optional) Play Dough Tubs in any color your child prefers
- (optional) 10 Count Markers or 12 Count Colored Pencils

You may also wish to have the following supplies at home: crayons, pencils, glue stick, safety scissors. You may be asked to provide additional crayons, pencils, and glue sticks as your child uses their supply.

As a summer reading project, please read any alphabet book (example: Chicka Chicka Boom Boom) with your child. Have your child make a simple poster and decorate it with pictures (photos, magazine, web, etc.) of things that they find that begin with the same letter as the first letter of their first name. For example, if your child's name is Grace, maybe they would include a picture of grapes and a goldfish.
